

Terms&conditions

Article 1: Definitions

1.1. In Maastrichts Mooiste general terms and conditions uses the following definitions:

- a. Event: the City Centre trail on Friday, the Walking event on Saturday and the running event Maastrichts Mooiste on Sunday.
- b. Participant: the natural person that registered at for participation at the presented system by the organization
- c. Agreement: The agreement reaching to participation of the participant in the event.
- d. Organiser: The legal entity (in this case Let's Move BV) that the participant has entered an agreement with.

1.2. These general terms and conditions apply to every agreement.

Article 2: Participation

2.1. A participant needs to be at a certain, set by the organiser, minimal age at the day of the event (at the 5km 13 year, at the 10km and 10em 16 years, City Centre Trail 13 years under guidance of an adult, at the walking events 8 year).

2.2. The participant is only allowed to participate if the registration form has been filled in truthfully, the registration fee is paid before the event and if the participant has agreed to the general terms and conditions.

2.3. Selling the starting tickets for the event is not allowed.

2.4. Only if you cancel before 19 May 2017 restitution of the registration fee and additional order a reimbursement can take place. At the reimbursement € 7,50 administration costs will be charged to the participant on the already paid registration fee and additional orders.

2.5. The organiser can decide to cancel the event at a late date in case of force majeure. In case of cancelation because of force majeure there won't be set a new date; the next edition will take place the next year. In that case, no restitution will be given. The participant keeps the right on the ordered running shirt, that will be sent by mail.

2.6. The organiser is not responsible for costs made by the participant in case the event is cancelled due to force majeure.

Article 3: Liability

3.1. Participation takes place at own risk. The organiser is not responsible for any damage, unless this damage is the direct consequence is of serious culpability or gross negligence of the organiser. The exclusion of liability also goes for severe damages, like all possible damages caused by injuries or passing away.

3.2. In case, despite the mentioned in article 3.1, the organiser is held liable for damage of the participant, the obligation for the organiser to compensate the damage will be limited to the amount that the insurance company of the organiser compensates in the case.

3.3. The participant need to be insured sufficiently for the risk of damage that the participants or his surviving relatives might suffer, caused by his dead, injury or illness, caused by his participation of the event.

3.4. The participant declares to be familiar with the fact that participation demands a good health, physically and mentally, and declares to fulfils this demand and has prepared by training or otherwise prepared for the event. The organiser advises the participant explicitly to do a sport medical check-up for participation in the event.

3.5. The participant safeguards the organiser for liability for damage that third parties might lead as consequence of an act that can be blame on deeds or negligence of deeds of the participant in relation to the event. The participant has to be insured sufficiently for the risk of liability for the mentioned damage.

3.6. The participant safeguards the organiser for liability for damage that the participant might suffer because of his participation in the event, unless the damaged is the direct consequence of serious culpability or gross negligence of the organiser.

Article 4: Portrait right

The participants grants permission to the organiser for usage and publishing of photos, images and other type of footages made during or around the event in which the participant is shown.

Article 5: Personal data

The by the participant provided personal data will be collected in a data file by the organiser. By participating in the event, a participant grants permission to the organiser for the use of this data to send information to the participant and (on condition that the participants grants permission in the registration form) to provide the personal data to third parties for sending information to the participant. By registering for the event and thereby entering the agreement, the participant grants permission to the organiser to publish his name and results (for example by publication in newspapers and internet). Besides that, the medical remarks can be used by the organiser during the event, in case an (medical) emergency.

Article 6: Regulations

The regulations of Maastrichts Mooiste apply to the participation of the participant in a Maastrichts Mooiste's event.
